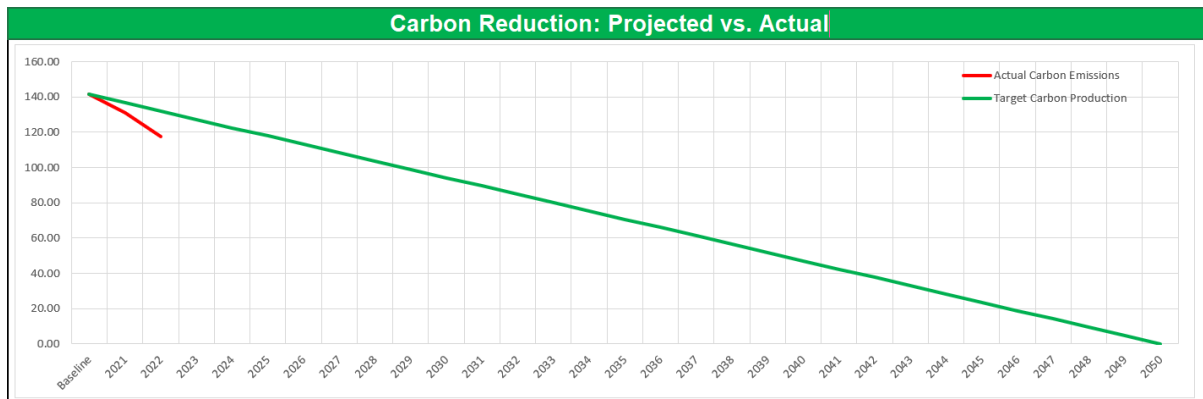

## Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 80 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2027 against a target of 108 tCCO<sub>2</sub>e. This is a reduction of 29%

## Carbon Reduction Projects

### Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2018/2019 baseline:

- Change to working from Home following the COVID lockdown.
- Reduction in business travel by using Microsoft Teams.
- Replacing physical servers with virtualized versions.

The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 23 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, a 16% reduction against the 2018/2019 baseline.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Further virtualization of the main services Ctalk provides.
- Closing the Head Office.
- **Sale/donation of furniture and equipment we no longer require to promote re-use.**

## Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
